

# BUYcott

As part of the BUYcott Campaign, we encourage you to write letters to Tesco and Waitrose. Email and postal addresses are at the bottom of this page.

**It is important that letters to supermarkets are clearly genuine and written by individuals. Here is some information you can use to write your letter to Tesco or Waitrose.**

- **Explain why you are writing**

The Palestine Solidarity Campaign is targeting Tesco and Waitrose with their latest boycott efforts. You are writing to let these supermarkets know that these views are not shared by all of their customers.

- **Explain why boycotts are negative**

Boycotts are divisive, negative and will not help to achieve peace. As the Israeli and Palestinian economies are so inextricably linked, a boycott of Israeli goods will certainly affect Palestinians too. The Palestine General Federation of Trade Unions is against boycotting Israeli goods. Furthermore, supermarkets should not become involved in political discussions.

- **Thank the supermarket for stocking Israeli goods.**

Despite all lobbying by the Palestinian groups so far, all of the supermarkets have refused to boycott Israeli goods.

- **Encourage the supermarkets to continue stocking these goods.**
